

2020 Muscle Car Show Covid-19 Safety Plan

1. General

All attendees to the event must abide by the requirements expressed in this document.

This COVID-19 plan must be distributed electronically in advance to those attending.

1.1. General Principles

- A strict limit of a minimum of 4 sqm per person with a separation of 1.5m between persons will be observed at all times during the event.
- Groups larger than 10 persons within a 40m2 area will not be permitted. Mixing of groups is not permitted.
- The event is limited to 100 attendees in total.
- Frequent cleaning and disinfection of common touch areas will be undertaken.
- Sharing of equipment is to be avoided.
- Sharing of food is to be avoided
- A record of all event attendees will be maintained by the organisers for the purposes of contact tracing.
- Take away food from vendor vehicle(s) only.
- Appropriate signage will be displayed around the venue encouraging social distancing
- Appropriate signage will be displayed on buildings advising attendees on number limits within the buildings.
- All attendees are encouraged to download the COVID-19 app prior to attending the event.

1.2. Attending the Event

Attendees to the event will be limited to:

- Authorised officials
- Entrants, family and friends of cars being displayed in the event
- Venue staff
- Essential contractors judges
- Sponsors staff

Spectators from the general public are not permitted at the event.

All show attendees must agree to this COVID-19 plan as a condition of entry to the event.

• Attendees to the event must not be showing any signs of cold or flu symptoms

- Attendees must not have been overseas in the previous 14 days, had contact with anyone confirmed with COVID-19 in the previous 14 days, or had contact with anyone who has been overseas in the previous 14 days
- If any attendees have previously been confirmed COVID-19 cases, they must supply a letter from a doctor confirming a negative test result for COVID-19.
- If after attending this event, an attendee is subsequently confirmed as a COVID-19 case up to 14 days after the event, or had contact with a known COVID case up to 14 days prior to the event, they must inform the event organisers.

1.3. Entry to the venue

All officials, contractors, staff and entrants entering the venue will have their contact tracing information recorded, Covid-19 risk questions asked and temperature checks undertaken at the venue entrance by the Venue Security staff.

At the entry to the Amaroo paddock entrants will be directed to their display location by a designated Club official.

1.4. Amenities

Social distancing protocols will be observed when using toilets facilities, including maximum capacity of the amenities themselves.

2. The Event

2.1. COVID-19 Marshall

A designated COVID-19 Marshall will monitor compliance with the COVID-19 plan and will direct transgressions to be promptly rectified. Non-compliance with these directions will result in the matter being referred to the event organiser. Possible consequences may include loss of points or exclusion from the event.

Commencement of the event will only occur when the COVID-19 Marshall informs the event organiser that the COVID-19 plan is being complied with.

Venue Security will retain records of names and contact tracing information of all attendees for a period of at least 28 days after the event. These records will only be used for the purposes of tracing COVID-19 infections.

2.2. Registration

Registration requirements for entrants must be completed online prior to the event. No face to face registration will be undertaken on the day.

Event briefing notes will be circulated to entrants via email prior to the event, and will be available to download from the <u>Muscle Car Show page</u> of the Club website.

2.3. Results

Results will be announced at the end of the event. Social distancing <u>must</u> be maintained at all times. Winners will pick up their trophy from the indicated location and will stand suitably distanced for an official photograph of their Award. Detailed results will be made available on the Club website and in the subsequent Club Magazine as soon as possible after the event.
