



2021 Brock Anniversary Run to Mount Panorama Motor Racing Track Bathurst Covid-19 Safety Plan

1. General

This Event is to comply with NSW Government restrictions for regional and rural NSW, in particular, Major Recreation Facility Covid-19 Health Orders for Motor Racing Tracks.

All attendees to the event must abide by the requirements expressed in this document.

This COVID-19 plan must be distributed electronically in advance to those attending.

1.1. General Principles

- A minimum of 2 sqm per person with a separation of 1.5m between persons will be observed at all times during the event.
- Masks are to be worn indoors.
- Sharing of food is to be avoided
- An electronic record of all event attendees will be maintained by the organisers for the purposes of contact tracing.
- All attendees are encouraged to download the Service NSW COVID-19 app prior to attending the event.

1.2. Attending the Event

Attendees to the event will be limited to those who have purchased tickets online via the www.hsvclubnsw.com website and will be issued wrist bands at their nominated Meeting Points.

The general public are not permitted at the event.

All attendees must agree to this COVID-19 plan as a condition of entry to the event.

- Attendees to the event must not be showing any signs of cold or flu symptoms
- Attendees must not have been overseas in the previous 14 days, had contact with anyone confirmed with COVID-19 in the previous 14 days, or had contact with anyone who has been overseas in the previous 14 days
- If any attendees have previously been confirmed COVID-19 cases, they must supply a letter from a doctor confirming a negative test result for COVID-19.

- If after attending this event, an attendee is subsequently confirmed as a COVID-19 case up to 14 days after the event, or had contact with a known COVID case up to 14 days prior to the event, they must inform the event organisers.

1.3. Entry to the venue

After the group photo shoot, only those who have wrist bands will be allowed entry to the event area at McPhillamy Park.

Once cars have parked at McPhillamy Park, attendees are to make their way to a suitable picnic location, observing hand hygiene and social distancing.

Mixing of groups must be minimised and the 1 person per 2 square metre rule observed.

1.4. Amenities

Social distancing protocols will be observed when using toilets facilities, including maximum capacity of the amenities themselves.

100% of the seating provided may be used with 1.5 metres distancing between attendees not from the same household.

It is recommended that attendees bring their own seating to help maintain the necessary distancing.

2. The Event

2.1. COVID-19 Marshall

A designated COVID-19 Marshall will monitor compliance with the COVID-19 plan and will direct transgressions to be promptly rectified. Non-compliance with these directions will result in the matter being referred to the event organiser.

2.2. Ticket Bookings

Ticket bookings for all attendees must be completed online prior to the event. No face to face registration will be undertaken on the day.

2.3. Catering

Lunch will be served to attendees to maintain the necessary hygiene.

Attendees are to queue at each lunch station and maintain a minimum of 1.5 metre distancing.

Hand sanitising will be available to maintain hand hygiene.

2.4. Record Keeping

Electronic records of all attendees to this event will be maintained for contact tracing purposes as required by Government Health Orders and will not be made available for any other use.
