### Event Information

Competitors gates open at 8am, registration and scrutineering 8am to 9.45am. A compulsory driver briefing will be held at around 10am with racing commencing thereafter.

**Registration: Drivers are to bring their printed order and photo identification as well as all their crew members and spectators with them to the registration desks in the scrutineering shed upon arrival.** The driver will be issued a pre- numbered entry form which should then be completed and submitted to collect your driver's wrist band. Crew members and spectators will be checked off the master list with the driver and issued wrist bands accordingly. Once drivers have registered and collected their wrist bands, they will need to take their car to scrutineering for safety checking and race number application.

The apparel requirements and other information is included on the **Supplementary Regulations** which you will need to read. Please make sure that your helmet has a AS/NZS1698 standard sticker on it, or at minimum complies with this standard. A summary of the requirements for the day is below.

Cars with a known potential to run quicker than 10.00 seconds (1/4 mile) are not permitted.

All drivers must hold a current civil driver's licence as a minimum.

P- Plate licences are acceptable; Learner's permits are not acceptable for cars.

Names of all crew and spectators need to be included in your entry and must appear on your printed order to gain admission.

If you have a IHRA drag licence, the IHRA licence number must be included on your entry, and you must present your IHRA drag licence during the registration and race under your IHEA licence during the hire day.

Entry fee includes a 1 day drag licence for those without a IHRA drag licence.

The Sydney Dragway Café will NOT be available for service on the day. Please bring your own food and non-alcoholic drinks or visit nearby establishments.

**Drivers must wear** an approved helmet (AS/NZS 1698 minimum as specified in the below table Minimum Vehicle Requirements) with long sleeved upper body garment, long pants and enclosed shoes, shoes and clothing must be of fire-resistant material.

Minimum lap- sash seat belt required (lap-only seat belts are not permitted).

No alcohol, glass containers, animals or fireworks permitted within the venue.

Minimum vehicle requirements are as per Table 1 in the following supplementary regulations, pages 3-8.

## **Definitions**

**Crewmember** means a participant who has entered to assist a nominated primary driver with his or her vehicle.

**Driver** means the driver entered to competitively drive a specified vehicle.

**Media Representative** means a pre-approved professional photographer or journalist.

**Participant** means any and all of the following. The hirer and any assistant/s appointed by the hirer, primary driver, approved multiple drivers, crewmember, spectator, media representative, service provider. SD means Sydney Dragway.

**Spectator** means a person who has entered to observe competition from designated spectator viewing areas.

**WSID** means Western Sydney International Dragway Ltd (WSID) trading as Sydney Dragway and included all the land and all the facilities upon that land which is under the control of Western Sydney Dragway International Dragway Ltd.

## **Terms and Conditions (General and Supplementary Regulations; Private Track Hire)**

- 1. Alcohol:** Sydney Dragway is an alcohol- free venue. No alcohol or alcoholic beverage of any description is to be brought into the venue by any participant at this club hire. Sydney Dragway reserves the right to search vehicles and containers of any description and to confiscate any alcohol or alcoholic beverages found until the completion of the club hire. A driver found with alcohol in his or her possession will be immediately disqualified from the participation in the club hire and may be subject to immediate removal from Sydney Dragway. No refund will be issued. If more than one driver is found with alcohol in their possession, the club hire may be cancelled entirely.
- 2. Animals:** Animals are not permitted at Sydney Dragway during any motorsport event. The animal handler/owner will be subject to immediate removal from Sydney Dragway.
- 3. Barbeques:** Privately operated gas barbeques are permitted but must operate in an area isolated from participants vehicle.
